

# FRISCO ISD HALL OF HONOR

## CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION/INDUCTION

### General Qualifications

- A. The following categories are eligible for nomination and induction:
  - 1. Athletes
  - 2. Coaches
  - 3. Contributors (Athletic Trainers, Team Doctors, Sports Writer, Announcer etc.)
  - 4. Teams
- B. Must have made an *exceptional* contribution to Frisco ISD athletics in one of the 4 categories listed in letter (A).
- C. Five (5) year waiting period after graduation. However, the Committee has the right to waive the five (5) year waiting period in extenuating circumstances.
- D. The nominees must be of good moral character as may be determined at the sole discretion of the Committee.

### Athletes

In addition to the general qualifications to be considered for individual induction the nominee must meet at least three (3) of the following criteria:

- A. Athletes must be a graduate of a Frisco ISD high school who participated in a Frisco ISD athletic program:
  - 1. Frisco High School
  - 2. Centennial High School
  - 3. Wakeland High School
  - 4. Liberty High School
  - 5. Heritage High School
  - 6. Lone Star High School
  - 7. Independence High School
  - 8. Reedy High School
  - 9. Lebanon Trail High School (2020 - 1st graduating class)
  - 10. Memorial High School (2020 - 1st graduating class)
  - 11. Emerson High School (2024 - 1st graduating class)
  - 12. Panther Creek High School (2024 - 1st graduating class)
- B. The nominee must have made truly *exceptional* contributions to their Frisco ISD high school's athletics program while enrolled as a student.
- C. Must have participated as a student athlete in a Frisco ISD high school's athletic program for a minimum of two (2) years at the Varsity level.
- D. Participated in athletic competition at the college and/or professional level.
- E. Named to a first team All-District in at least two (2) sports for two (2) years, or three (3) years in one sport.

### Teams

In addition to the general qualifications a team must meet one (1) of the following listed below. A.

Winners of a State Championship.

**B.** Teams considered for induction must have competed in the state playoff system or have been state qualifiers representing a Frisco ISD high school.

**C.** Teams considered for induction prior to the inception of the state playoff system must have won a district or bi-district championship.

### **Coaches**

In addition to the general qualifications to be considered for induction the coach must meet at least two (2) of the following criteria:

**A.** Demonstrated success not only with a win/loss record but also with purpose, goals, and loyalty to the Frisco ISD athletic programs he/she represents.

**B.** State Championship

**C.** Participated in no less than five (5) seasons of playoff qualification.

**D.** Continuous athletic tenure in Frisco ISD for a period of no less than ten years or total athletic tenure of no less than fifteen years.

### **Contributors**

Contributors/Supporters are individuals who have made a *significant* contribution including time, talent, support or funding to enhance the Frisco ISD Athletics Program.

**A.** Candidates shall include but are not limited to teachers, administrators, athletic trainers, announcers, sports writers, school patrons and Frisco ISD staff.
