What is Dual Credit?

- Dual credit allows students to earn high school and college credit at the same time.
- High school students enroll in university classes and upon successful completion, credits will apply to high school graduation AND a college degree.
- The courses will appear on a high school and college transcript.



Dual Credit Benefits

- Earn dual credit from a Tier 1 Public Research University
- Get a head start on a bachelor's degree by completing the Texas Core Curriculum
- Gain transferable credit toward bachelor degrees
- Receive discounted UNT tuition
- Earn weighted high school GPA

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Courses

The program focuses on the 42-semester credit hour Texas Core Curriculum. Core requirements are common to all public colleges and universities in Texas. A completed Texas Core Curriculum is fully transferrable between public higher education institutions in Texas.

Some things to consider . . .

Demonstration of College Readiness

- Admitted as a non-degree seeking student
- Must demonstrate college-readiness after 2nd semester in program:
 - Reading/Writing: Pass Freshman Writing course.
 - Math: Must meet math readiness requirement with an exam score

SAT	530
TSIA2	CTC 950 OR CRC 910-949 AND Diagnostic Level 6
AP	Calculus: 3 or Statistics: 3

Some things to consider . . .

Major Requirements

- NTN courses meet core requirements, but may not meet specific course requirements for all majors

Dual Credit courses are college courses

- Courses are rigorous
- You will have homework, projects, tests, papers, etc.
- 12 SCH is a full-time load at the university
- Course grades remain on your college transcript

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Costs

UNT offers reduced tuition and fees for dual credit courses.

Tuition = \$50 per credit hour

Fees = \$25 per credit hour

Cost of a Typical Three Credit Hour Course	Dual Credit Tuition	Regular UNT Tuition
Tuition per 3-credit course	\$150	\$1013
Dual credit fee per 3-credit course	\$ 75	\$377
Total Per Course	\$225	\$1390
Total Per Semester year 1	\$900*	\$5,560*

*does not include textbooks, Lab fees, supplies, or a one-time application fee of \$75

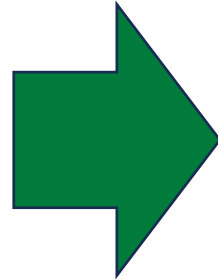

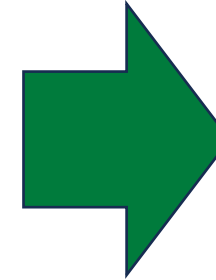
