Summer Success with Apex is an online program that will offer students access to personalized instruction in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies, as well as STAAR and College Readiness tutorials. Students may choose any content to practice this summer and self-enroll with their Campus eCodes. Students can access Apex on their phones, ipads, chromebooks, laptops, etc.

10. Enter your **Campus Enrollment Code** and click **Next**.

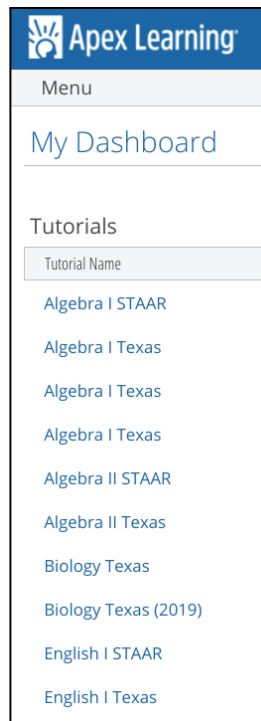

11. Once you enter the enrollment code, click **Enroll**.

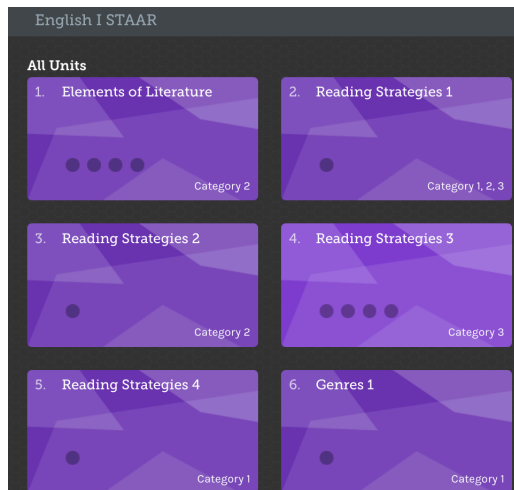
